
## GETTING THERE: OIL PAINTINGS BY JENNY FERGUSON

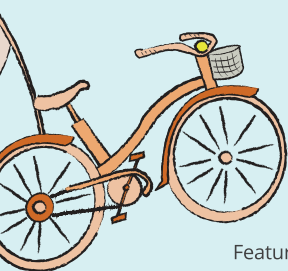

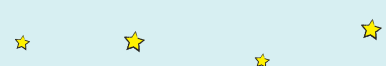
